Bronte possesses a beautiful pier and waterfront walkway where residents and travelers alike are invited to stroll the shores of Lake Ontario in every season. With a picturesque lighthouse overlooking the pier, a full marina of boats and watercraft, as well as a quaint downtown area you may find that this feels more like something from the shores of a New England community, but it is all ours.

The proposed education-centered garden, park and skateway are a region-wide project of the Bronte Butterfly Foundation. It will be a year-round gathering place for residents and visitors and of special interest to families and children of all ages. For today and tomorrow, Bronte remains an area of unchanging appeal.
